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## Schedule

### Travel

Our travel to Oklahoma will take two days via bus leaving FBC Chickamauga immediately following the 8:30 am service on June 11. From there we will travel to Arkansas where we will stay at a 2<sup>nd</sup> Baptist Conway that will be lending us floors to sleep on (so bring air mattresses). We should arrive in Arkansas around 6 pm. After we stay the night and eat a quick breakfast, we will hit the road again around 6 am and hopefully arrive in Davis, Oklahoma a little after lunchtime on Monday, June 12<sup>th</sup>. Our return trip will be very similar leaving Oklahoma in mid-morning Friday, June 16<sup>th</sup> staying the night at First Baptist Jacksonville in Arkansas, and arriving back at FBC Chickamauga a little after lunch on Saturday, June 17<sup>th</sup>.

**PACK A LUNCH FOR YOUR STUDENT FOR JUNE 11. WE ARE NOT STOPPING FOR LUNCH**

We ask that students pack an overnight bag they can keep with them so we don't have to unload the entire bus at 2<sup>nd</sup> Baptist Conway, and 1<sup>st</sup> Baptist Jacksonville. A packing list will be included in this document.

## Rules & Expectations

### Cellphones/Devices

Once we arrive at camp, we will ask all the students to turn in their phones or other devices to minimize the distractions that come from texting, social media, etc. The phones will be kept with Chris and the students will have access to them and will be asked to make sure they call home once a day or so (more if desired). All adult leaders and interns will have their phones and I will make sure all parents have those numbers to contact in case of an emergency.

### Breakouts

One of the great things that Falls Creek offers is breakouts every afternoon in addition to recreational activities. These breakouts are designed to help students grow spiritually in various specific areas of spiritual life. In the past, we have not required attendance to these. This year however **WE ARE REQUIRING** that every student attend at least one breakout over the week we are at camp because of the spiritual benefit they provide.

### Travel

The trip from here to Oklahoma is a long drive, in cramped quarters on a bus. We expect the students to be respectful of each other. We also will expect *all students* to help clean the buses and churches we stay at.

### Camp Rules

While we are at camp all students will be expected to adhere to the rules and regulations laid out by Falls Creek camp including dress code.

### Dress Code

The dress code at camp is not something that we at FEC have any control over. At camp, we are expected to dress in a certain way and the camp is strict about it. Please ensure that your camper brings clothes/swimsuits that are in



accordance with this dress code as there will be nothing that the leaders of FEC can do if a camper is forced to sit out because of a dress code violation. Below I have included the dress code that you can review with your camper.

# DRESS CODE

All apparel judgements will be left to the discretion of the Falls Creek Staff (FCS). If FCS determines a camper or campers should change their clothing to fall in line with camp requirements, then said camper or campers are required to do so.

**ALWAYS ACCEPTABLE SHIRTS**

Shorts must be modest. Modest can be generally defined as extending to just beyond the finger tips or a 5" to 7" inseam.

Sleeveless shirts must extend all the way to the shoulder seam.

Dresses/Skirts must reach the top of the knee.

Shoes must be worn at all times outside of your cabin.

Tights may be worn under a garment that meets the dress code. No tight fitting or revealing clothing. This includes leggings or similar attire, which cannot be worn as pants.

## SWIMWEAR

T-shirts and cover-ups must be worn to and from swimming venues.

**male** **female**

Should wear swimsuits of modest length (fingertip) and not tight fitting. Modest one-piece.

**male** **female**

No short shorts/ or tight-fitting shorts. No two-pieces.

Campers may not be barefoot on the way to and from venues.

## WHAT NOT TO WEAR

No tank tops or shirts cut down the sides.

Undergarments must always be covered by outer garments (i.e. no boxer shorts hanging out or bra straps showing).

No Midriifs/racer backs. No sport bras as tops (includes the 5k).

No spaghetti strap tank tops/dresses.

Apparel may not display tobacco, alcohol, controlled substances, or inappropriate language or pictures.



## Sign Up & Payment

The cost per student will be \$150. If your camper is intending on coming, please sign up via the QR code in the bottom right of this page. This will bring you to the church portion waiver that will be filled out so that we can have your student down as attending. There will be an additional waiver that Falls Creek requires that will need to be filled out that is at the back of this packet.

A deposit of \$50 is due no later than May 31, 2023, if your student is intending on going. All waivers and payments are due in full no later than Wednesday, June 7, 2023. You can pay in cash or with a check directly to Chris or in the offering plate. Please make sure that cash is in an envelope with the camper's name on it. Any checks should be made out to FCC Chickamauga.

If for whatever reason you need financial assistance for your student to go to camp that is okay! We have scholarship money available and we can certainly work something out. Money will never be a reason someone cannot go to camp.

## Packing List

Please ensure that an overnight bag is packed for our stays in Arkansas both on the way out and back. There was some confusion about this last year. Your student needs to have everything they will need to shower, change clothes, and sleep in a bag that they will carry with them. All other luggage will be packed on a bus and will be inaccessible until we are at camp.

It is also recommended that students bring some spending money to buy snacks or souvenirs from the camp gift store.

## Falls Creek Youth Camp 2023 Student Release and Waiver of Claims Form (2 of 2)

**I understand that it is the responsibility of my child's Host Church to obtain insurance permission for treatment or to limit my child's recreational activities because of a stated medical condition.**

My child, \_\_\_\_\_ will be attending Falls Creek Youth Camp during the summer session, 2023. Falls Creek Conference Center is managed and operated by the Baptist General Convention of Oklahoma ("Oklahoma Baptists"). In the event that my child should need emergency medical care or attention, the Host Church leadership, Oklahoma Baptists or any of their agents or employees is hereby authorized to consent to the provision of such emergency medical care, including without limitation, medical, dental, surgical care, or hospitalization, to my child as is recommended or suggested by a physician, nurse, surgeon, or other health care professional.

- If such emergency care is provided, I understand that my child's health insurance information will be given to the health care professional and that any expenses not covered by my insurance shall be my responsibility. I understand that the Host Church or Oklahoma Baptists will not be obligated to pay either the health care professional or me for any medical expenses incurred.
- There are instances when third party contractors are used to operate and supervise various events and activities. In those instances where third party contractors are used, I agree that neither the Host Church nor Oklahoma Baptists is responsible for the action of these third party contractors. I further agree that neither the Host Church nor Oklahoma Baptists is liable for the actions or activities of participants or sponsors participating in events or activities operated by third party contractors.
- I understand that the risk of injury from recreational activity is significant, including but not limited to, the potential for permanent paralysis and death. While particular rules, equipment, and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious injury does exist. I knowingly and freely assume all risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from negligence, and assume full responsibility for my child's participation in or observation of such recreational activity.
- Furthermore, in consideration of my child being allowed to attend Falls Creek Youth Camp, I, on behalf of myself and my child, hereby waive, and I hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Host Church, Oklahoma Baptists, their agents or employees, against any and all causes of action, rights, claims or suits which I or my child may have against the Host Church, Oklahoma Baptists, or their agents or employees as a result of injury to my child, including, but not limited to: (1) injuries arising from my child's participation in or observation of recreational activities at Falls Creek Youth Camp, and (2) injuries arising from the decision of the leadership of the Host Church, Oklahoma Baptists, or any of their agents or employees to consent to the provision of emergency medical care to my child.
- I understand that my child's image may be included in a video or in photographs that may be made during camp. I understand that a promotional or highlight video may be available for sale during and after camp. I consent that my child's image may appear on videos, promotional resources, camp endorsed web sites, etc.
- I give authority and permission to the Host Church, Oklahoma Baptists, and any of their staff or agents to inspect my child's belongings while at Falls Creek Youth Camp.
- I understand that Falls Creek Youth Camp is a place where many students seek counsel and advice from adult leaders, staff, counselors and others. I hereby consent to my child receiving spiritual and emotional counsel during their week of camp.
- I have received and read the Parent Information about Falls Creek Youth Camp including the list of the recreational options and the daily schedule, and I have received satisfactory answers to all my questions about such information. I have read the Falls Creek Youth Camp Code of Conduct and Dress Code, and I have discussed the Code of Conduct and dress code with my child.
